Coors Beer wants us to patronize their products on St. Patrick's Day. But the Coors family has opposed the rights of immigrants in America. And the owner of Coors' San Francisco distributor, David Ingram, has contributed thousands of dollars to the most anti-immigrant lawmakers in Congress.

So it's no surprise that Ingram's DBI Beverage, Inc. implemented a discriminatory wage system in Sacramento and in Stockton, where many workers have an immigrant background. In South San Francisco, DBI wants to reduce benefits and working conditions for its mostly female customer service workforce that will still be provided to DBI's male warehouse workers and drivers.
