UPS Freight and the Union have agreed to an extension of the current UPS Freight National Agreement in order to give the parties time to continue negotiations. The extension does not have a specific end date, but can be terminated by either side with a 30-day notice.

This means the current Agreement will remain in place until the Agreement has been revoted and accepted by the members. Any increases in wages and pensions will be made retroactively to August 1, 2013, but will not take effect until the Agreement has been revoted and agreed to.
